USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES

CART PATHS: Relief from concrete or asphalt paved paths only. Rule 24-2.

LATERAL HAZARDS: Red stakes or lines on Nos. 4, 8, 15 and 17. Rule 26-1a, b, c.

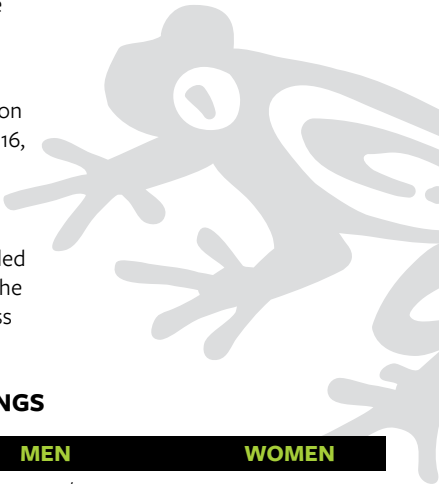
WATER HAZARDS: Yellow stakes on Nos. 10 and 17. Rule 26-1a, b.

OUT OF BOUNDS: White stakes and boundary fences on Nos. 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 16, 17 and 18. Rule 27-1b.

LOCAL RULE: App. A.3a. Embedded ball. The embedded ball rule is in effect through the green, including rough, unless the ball is in a hazard.

LOCAL RULE: Mandatory relief from all flower beds. Rule 25-1.

LOCAL RULE: All animal hoof prints are treated as Ground Under Repair over the entire golf course except water hazards. Decision 33-8/32, Rule 25-1.
